

A NEW HEART IS NEEDED

"But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God" (Romans 2:5) Jeremiah said this: *"The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?"* (Jeremiah 17:9).

We take the heart to mean the inward motivations, which control a person's words or deeds. According to Jeremiah the heart is wicked and deceptive and no one can understand his own heart but God does.

It is so important that we urgently need a new heart, and we can have a new heart, if we so desire to have it.

It is recorded in the Bible. Notice: *"A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh"* (Ezekiel 36:26).

In the book of Hebrews God says: *"This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them"* (Hebrews 10:16) Our problem with the heart is our

attitude. Our hearts can become hard hearts as those mentioned in the book of Hebrews. *"Harden not your hearts, as in the provocation, in the day of temptation in the wilderness:"* (Hebrews 3:8). *"While it is said, Today if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts, as in the provocation"* (Hebrews 3:15).

Because of the hardening of their hearts notice what happens. *"Wherefore I was grieved with that generation, and said, They do alway err in their heart; and they have not known my ways"* (Hebrews 3:10).

Because of that they departed from the living God. It becomes an unbelieving heart, a heart that refuses to receive the truth and obey the truth and the results is a wicked heart. So what kind of heart do you have, is it a hard heart, or one that will surrender to the Lord?
