

CLAY IN POTTERS' HAND

In the book of Jeremiah 18:1-6, Jeremiah is told to go to the potter house, and there he would hear the words of the Lord. "Then the word of the Lord came to me, saying, O house of Israel, cannot I do with you as this potter? saith the Lord. Behold, as the clay is in the potter's hand, so are ye in mine hand, O house of Israel" (Jeremiah 18:5-6).

The Lord Himself is the Potter. What possibilities there are for us, as for Israel, being in His hand? Think of ourselves, and the position we have as children of God being a part of the church of our Lord, and you being clay in the Lord's hand. When we allow His mighty hand upon us we can accomplish much.

See what Nehemiah was able to accomplish because of the hand of God upon him. "And a letter unto Asaph, the keeper of the king's forest, that he may give me timber to make beams for the gates of the palace which, appertained to the house, and for the wall of the city, and for the house that I shall enter into. And the king granted me, according to the good hand of my God upon me" (Nehemiah 2:8).

The Potter's purpose, is to make the best possible use of the material that is in his hand. In his hands if we are pliable, He can mold us into the kind of person that can be useful in His kingdom.

Even though one might be marred, if he or she will yield to the Lord's will he can turn one from a vessel of dishonor to a vessel of honor.

The question is can God do with you, as the potter can. Are you as clay? Soft, pliable, and refined in His hand?

If so the Potter's purpose can be fulfilled in you.
