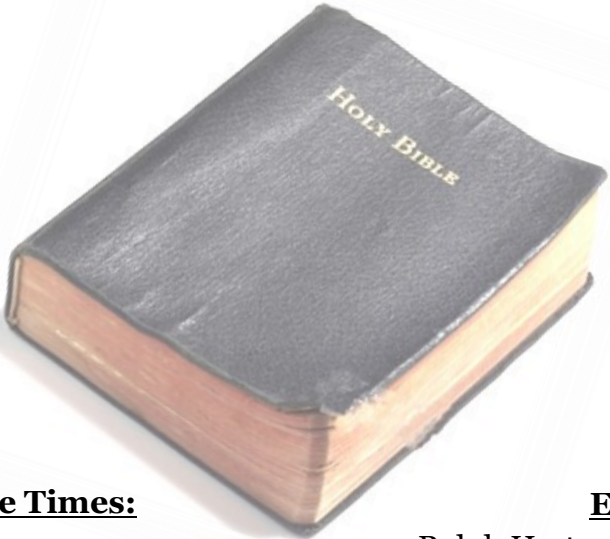

Forgetting

In the book of James, we read these words; "But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed" (James 1:25).

Here, we are reminded to not be a forgetful hearer. Many folks read the Bible, see, and understand what it says but, go away, and forget about the importance of doing. We never need to forget the things that are important.

Of course there are some things that we need to forget. Paul said: "Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 3:13-14).

And let us always remember the blessing of God. James said this: "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning" (James 1:17).
