

**THE PROPOSAL MADE TO HIM**

When Jesus was on the cross this is what was said to him. "Descend from the Cross that we may see and believe" (Mark 15:32).

They might as well say let God change His character and purposes that they might see and believe.

The thing about this is He could not descend from the cross because.

He would not disobey the Father. You remember He had prayed if there is any other say let this cup pass from me, not my will but thine be done: (Mark 14:36).
