Dear Brethren:

During January, brother Roger Campbell preached a three-day meeting for us while here from the States. He and his family lived and labored for the church in Taiwan for several years quite some time ago. Now, he occasionally returns to the island to assist the church a few weeks at a time.

The only time slot available for Kaohsiung was Monday the 26<sup>th</sup> through Wednesday the 28<sup>th</sup>. We would have preferred having him here for at least one Sunday. This is especially desirable in our situation since many of our members must travel considerable distances, work long hours, or both, making a weeknight assembly very difficult to attend. Every Sunday morning, we have brethren who must travel an hour or two or more to attend. On the second and third day of this meeting, a sister in Christ spent a little over three hours traveling to be with us, staying the intervening night with her cousin. She was only able to arrange the time for this because she is a manager for her employer. After the last night's lesson and fellowship, and facing another three-hour trip back, we invited her to stay the night with us and set out in the morning. She declined, stating that she needed to be at work early the next day.

Over the course of the meeting, we had two or three persons join online, for which we were grateful. An online presence should never be considered an acceptable substitute for attending in person when one's bodily presence is feasible and practical. Yet we are grateful for the technology that brings us together around the Bible though separated by great distances.

We had a particularly interesting question and answer session the second night of the meeting. One question dominated the remainder of the session that evening. That question was whether a person who had been baptized should afterward be encouraged to attend a denomination if there were no congregation of our Lord's church in the vicinity. The answer should be an interesting subject to address in a future newsletter.

We had two visitors the second night. One was a neighbor, the other was a man with whom I have been studying the Bible and who also occasionally comes Sunday mornings. During the day, we introduced brother Campbell to some persons who did not attend any of the nightly sessions. We hope and pray the visits and the preaching will produce fruit in due season.

A lady with whom I have studied in the past, and with whom Natasha is currently studying, came to our house for an individual study with brother Campbell. That study lasted over two hours. She had prepared two pages of questions to ask our brother. The study went well, and as she was leaving, it was obvious that she had thoroughly enjoyed her time with our brother.

Brother Campbell and I also found a little time to discuss the Scriptures together. Steel sharpens steel. I wish we had more time to sit together and share the fruit of our individual meditations upon God's word. Personally, I am always keenly curious to know what is being taught elsewhere, as to subject and the defining details. If you share such an interest, you might like to see the titles of brother Campbell's three evening lessons:

Monday the 26<sup>th</sup> – Jesus' Deity and His Cross  
Tuesday the 27<sup>th</sup> – Jesus' Authority and His Unique Church  
Wednesday the 28<sup>th</sup> – Jesus' Salvation and His Coming Again
