

**WHAT BAPTISM IMPLIES**

“Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ, were baptized into his death? Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead, by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection” (Romans 6:3-5).

First of all you will notice in verse three that it implies death. This is not a figure of speech, but a reality. Before baptism I was dead because of my sins.

Based on verse 4, one is buried with Christ. This is not only burial in water but into the death of Christ.

It also speaks of a resurrection. We are buried with Him wherein also we are raised with Him (Colossians 2:12). “Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead”. It also implies a likeness.

Verse 5 says “...we have been planted in the likeness of his death...” Read also Galatians 3:27.

I think we can also say it implies unity. “For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit” (1 Corinthians 12:13).

When we are baptized into Christ for the right reason we become members of the one body and are all one in Him. Now following Christ truth and living according to His word.
