Dear supporters of Amerindian Missions,

The brethren in Guyana and I are so thankful for your support over the years of the mission work in Guyana. Without support from dedicated brethren this work could not be done. Because of your dedicated support, I hope you will be able to help with two problems we are now facing.

First, Amerindian Missions has 22 church buildings some with preacher's houses that need repairs. Over the years the heavy rain and hot sun have deteriorated the handmade cement blocks that make the exterior walls of these church buildings and preacher's houses. Painting the blocks only lasts for about 4 or 5 years. We need to plaster the buildings and then paint them; also, we need to replace wooden doors and frames, windows and window frames and benches.


Second, we need our own transportation when we go into the villages, instead of paying someone to take us in and out and not having a way around till they come to pick us up.

I have found a Toyota van for sale that is in very good shape for \$15,000.00 and needs no repairs. The cost to plaster and paint the buildings is about \$2,500 to \$3,000 each depending on the size of the building. If you can help in any way with either or both it would be greatly appreciated. If you can help, please note purpose of funds on your check for van or buildings.
