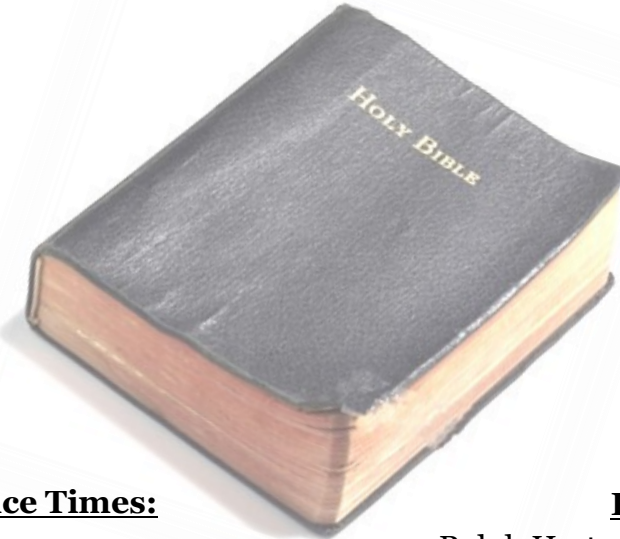

THE GOOD SHEPHERD JOHN 10:11-18

From the text we can see that Jesus is the good, and perfect Shepherd. All others that came before Him are thieves and robbers. There is only one Good Shepherd who came, and can lay down His life for the sheep, and take it again (v.18).

Notice some things about this Good Shepherd. "He Giveth His Life for the Sheep" (v.11). He is not only ready to sacrifice His life in defense of the sheep, but has a command from the Father to lay down His life for the sheep (v. 18). That is so the sheep might have life more abundant (v. 10).

The Father love the Son because, He willingly obeyed this command to lay down His life for the salvation of all who would enter the door by obedience (1 Peter 1:22-23).

Another thing that we see in this chapter is, "His Sheep Hear His Voice (v.16). I know for a fact, that sheep will listen to the voice of the shepherd. So every soul that will follow Christ must hear His voice. Of course we hear Him through the written word or the proclaiming of the gospel.

His words went first to the lost sheep of Israel, but then to all. For He said I have those which were not of that flock, and through His death all people who listen to the voice of the Good Shepherd could have salvation.

Christ also knows His sheep and the sheep know him (v.14). Isn't it good that our Lord knows us and we know Him? Let me add that we are owned by Him. He has paid the price for us by the shedding of His blood (Acts 20:28).

"Even as the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many" (Matthew 20:28).

"Who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time" (1 Timothy 2:6).

There is more that could be said but, does this fact not touch your heart so you want to obey Him?
