Dear Brethren, Red Hill Church Of Christ

Renee and I have returned from another successful evangelism mission trip in India. Sadly, Renee's mother passed away this past October after a long battle with dementia. However, she was able to return to India with me once again. The brothers and sisters rejoiced her presence, and she had plenty of opportunity to teach lady's bible classes and children's bible classes.

On this trip we had much to discuss with the brothers regarding the business side of the mission work. There were board trust documents to finalize, new school of preaching program curriculum discussion, inspection of the properties we support, new preachers on board, and several other things. By God's good grace we got those matters settled and following up now that we are back in the US.

On our way back from Bagdogra, we stopped in for a visit to Jaipur. Jaipur is also called the "Pink City" with several of its buildings painted a shade of pink in honor of the visiting Prince of Wales back in 1876. It symbolized hospitality and warmth, a tradition that continues to define the city today. We met four brothers who traveled in a bus all night for a gospel meeting and to meet with us. Their work is west of the city in farming lands, where they work in the day, and preach the gospel at night. It was good to share fellowship with them, and to assist their work with some benevolent funds.

We also have a new school of preaching in the planning phase. We are going to initiate a new bible school training curriculum that will be in session for ten months, teaching one week per month. We are discussing the names Elijah, Nehemiah, and Ester for these new Long-Term Bible Schools in three different locations. This program became necessary due to the number of potential students in the area, as well as providing students with time to attend without leaving their jobs or their families for an extended period, and more cost effective. There are two buildings in place that we will utilize, and a third we plan to begin construction this summer in Kadavakuduru where our brother P. Joseph preaches. We will build on property already available to us and the cost will be appx \$55,000. We are looking and planning for the funds in hopes of starting the program in February of 2027.

In Pamidipadu the school for the 2026 graduation class is underway. This school year we have room for more students by adding a new dormitory on the top of the guest house, due to a generous donation from one of our contributors whose hearts were moved to see that project completed. We turned a roof into a nice dormitory for approximately eight more students, and three teachers. As you know, we teach the men to be preachers, and we teach a women's bible class that we call the Priscilla Bible School for women. However, after ten years, we have not associated the men's school with a biblical name. And so, this year we have decided to call it the Apollos School of Preaching, referring to Acts 18:24-28. Apollos is a significant figure in the New Testament, known for his eloquence and deep knowledge of the Scriptures. He was a Jew from Alexandria and played an important role in the early development of the churches in Ephesus and Corinth. Apollos is described as mighty in the Scriptures, fervent in spirit, and instructed in the way of the Lord. He is mentioned primarily in the Acts of the Apostles and in 1st Corinthians, where he is recognized as a contemporary and colleague of the Apostle Paul. Apollos contributed significantly to the early church.

A little further north, our brother P. David has moved into the new building under construction for his congregation. While the building construction has not been fully completed, brother David and the church in Mangalagiri are able to worship and study there. As the new year began, brother David and other church members preached in Epuru, Uddandai Palem, and Kantheru villages, spreading the gospel. Just a few weeks ago, they taught the truth to one denominational preacher and his wife named K S Marsilamani from Epuru. They continue to study the truth together. As a result of our most recent visit, six new brothers and sisters were baptized. Also, while visiting local congregations in Peddapudi and Guntur, two new sisters in Christ were baptized. Every month brother David attends monthly bible classes at Mangalagiri, Guntur, Vijayawada, Tenali, Gudivada and Battiprolu, where denominational preachers attend to learn more of the truth.

Up on the border of Nepal, our Bagdogra Berean School of preaching is also underway, which always has rich mixture of students north and south of the border. Over the past three to four months, the Lord has kept brother Joseph Khati very active in the work through local preaching, teaching, follow up, and travels across different regions for gospel meetings and encouragement of the brethren. Just in the past four months, the brothers have visited 250 meetings in 5 districts that resulted in 128 new souls baptized (including 5 denominational preachers). Our Berean Bible school new graduate students started 4 new congregations in 4 different villages. They are preparing for 7 new gospel meetings above and below the border, as well as youth meetings targeting teach 1000 children in our VBS programs in the month of April and May.

In Bhopal, the home of one of the new long-term schools of preaching, brother Boaz continues to grow his congregation, focusing on younger adults. His recent gospel meeting programs include locations such as Govindpura, Bhel, Ayodhya Bypass, and Indrapurit. The brethren are good at sending pictures of their events. Further south in Kurnool, our brother and preacher, brother Job, is preparing to run and teach our third long term bible school as well. And these are all just the highlights of the continuous work that is accomplished by our supported preachers.

We have yet again, by God's good grace, traveled to the many locations in India, teaching and preaching the gospel and strengthening the brethren. We as always ask for your prayers, "...praying for us as well, that God may open up to us a door for the word, so that we may speak forth the mystery of Christ..." – Col 4:3

The Lord's work will continue throughout the year and continue until Renee and I return. We have already begun our plans and travels to the brethren here in the US, reporting on the work, visiting as many of the supporting congregations and brethren as possible. If we have visited your location and you would like a visit and a presentation of the work, let us know!

Thank you for your continued support that brings joy to our hearts, "For it is only right for me to feel this way about you all, because I have you in my heart...in the defense and confirmation of the gospel, you are all partakers of grace with me." – Phil 1:7.
