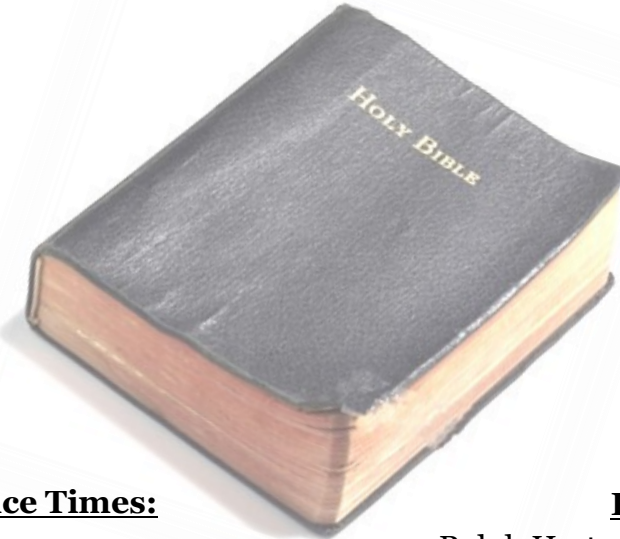

**CHRIST OUR ARK**

Christ is God's open door of salvation, as the Ark in Noah's day was a place of salvation from the flood. The ark was a place of refuge. This was God's appointed way of salvation. Christ is God's appointed way of salvation for us today.

In Christ there is safety. The Bible says: "There is therefore now, no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit" (Romans 8:1).

Christ also provides a place of separation. People that are saved are always set apart for God. "But know that the Lord hath set apart him that is godly for himself: the Lord will hear when I call unto

him" (Psalms 4:3).

In Christ, like Noah in the ark, we are in a place of safety. As long as we are in Christ, and faithful we are safe from the clutches of Satan. The problem with many people is, they do not heed Christ's invitation to come to Him for salvation.

Instead of obeying and entering, some just look. Their interest only causes them to take a passing glance at the great salvation offered. Others may talk about it. They are only curious concerning, but never respond.

Of course in this sinful world there are those who sneer, and mock at it. They laugh at those who accept, and think they are foolish. There is the need to accept the offer.

In Noah's day he along with his family had to enter the Ark, and today we must enter Christ. It takes belief, and then you have to decide to take the necessary steps.

The question is, will you decide to accept the Lord on His terms, and seek salvation, separation, and safety?
