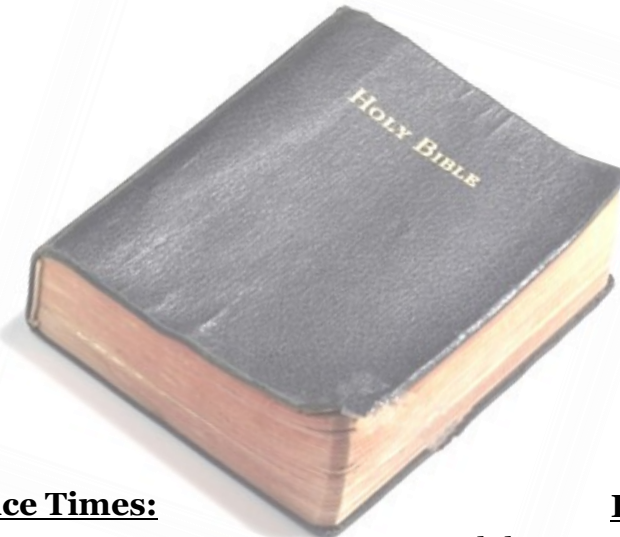

Glorifying God

“If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God; if any man minister, let him do it as of the ability which God giveth: that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom be praise and dominion for ever and ever” (1 Peter 4:11).

One of the things that we are to do is glorify God. To honor Him. And every Christian should have a desire to glorify God, and no self or someone else.

We read in the Bible where there were those who knew God, but did not glorify Him. (Romans 1:21).

Back in the Old Testament in the book of Daniel, we read about Belshazzar. He was found wanting in Daniel 5:27, but in verse 23 it reads in the later part of the verse “....and the God in whose hand thy breath is, and whose are all thy ways, hast thou not glori-

fied” (Daniel 5:23).

A way to glorify God is to give praise to Him. “Whoso offereth praise glorifieth me: and to him that ordereth his conversation aright will I shew the salvation of God” (Psalm 50:23).

The Psalmist also said: “I will praise thee, O Lord my God, with all my heart: and I will glorify thy name for evermore” (Psalm 86:12). Paul penned these words: “That ye may with one mind and one mouth glorify God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ” (Romans 15:6).

We need to remember to do this now, but one day all those who are saved will glorify Him. “And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, be unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever” (Revelation 5:13).

Our God is so worthy to be praised, and glorified.
