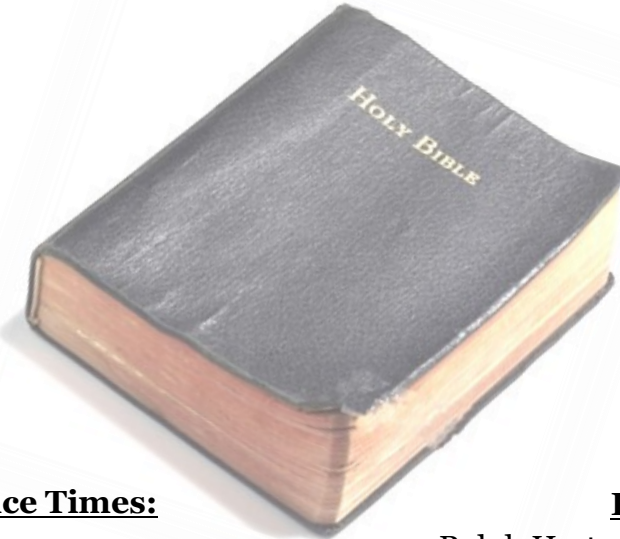

CHANGE WITHIN

“Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. 16, For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. 17, And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth forever” (1 John 2:15-17).

There has to be a changing of the mind from worldly things to the things of Christ.

In Phillips translation of Romans 12:2, it says: “Don’t let the world around you squeeze you into its own mold, but let God remold your minds from within”.

Why do so many love to be conformists? They want to be like those around them. They don’t want to wear clothes different for the other person. They want to

look similar to others. When it comes to superficial things it doesn’t matter, but when it comes to principles, it becomes serious, and far-reaching. These are things we have to face with a strong faith having armed ourselves with the armor of God, so we are able to stand strong in the face of all the things the world throws at us without giving up.

Don’t allow the things of this world to pull you into its mold but allow God to remold your mind and be ye steadfast.
