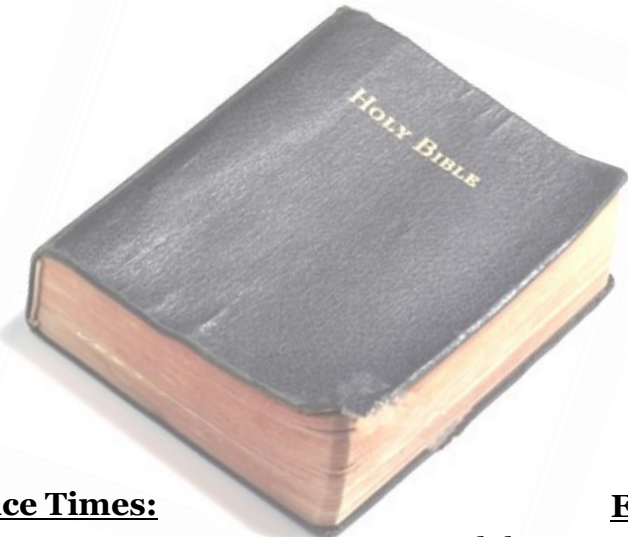

A FELLOWSHIP

The church is a fellowship. Reference is **not** made to eating a pot luck together, though Christians may often eat together.

Rather, the church is made of people who are bound together by their common commitment to Christ. Each appreciates the other, though not condoning sin.

This set of ties is stronger than blood. Once while Jesus was teaching He was interrupted with the news that His mother and brothers were outside.

Said He, "And who is my mother and who is my brethren?" Then as a good teacher often does.

He answered His own question, by saying, "Those who do the will of my Father are my mother and brethren." (Mark 3:31-35.)

As Christians, we are partners, not competitors. Paul said, "If one member suffers, all suffer together; if one member is honored, all rejoice together." (1 Cor. 12:26.)

Christians are members of the same body; they are all on the same team. Thereby we should all as Paul says, 1 Corinthians 1:10 "Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment."

What damages one is bad for all; when one wins a victory it is a blessing to all.
