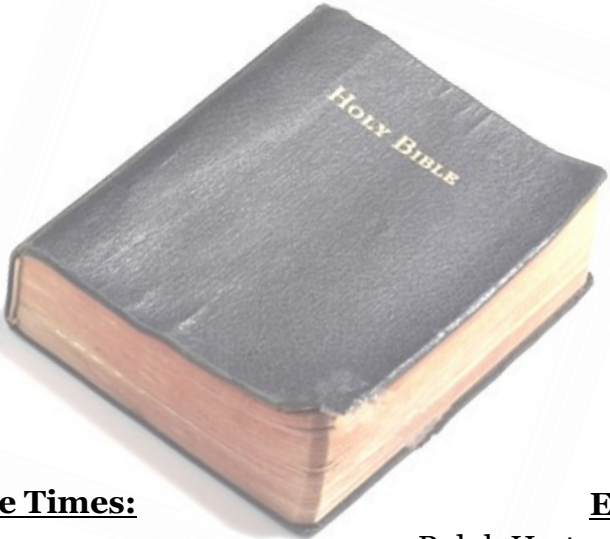

Is Bible Class Important

Does attending Bible class regularly make any difference in the quality of one's life?

With all the pressures that children, and young people face today, regular attendance to Bible class helps to mold their character, and fortify them against evil.

Consider this: In a five-year period, Judge Fossett in Brooklyn sentenced 2,400 juveniles to the reformatory. His investigation showed that not one of them was a member of a Bible class anywhere.

In a two-year period, Lee Baxton presided over 2,400 juvenile cases. He had a standing offer to pay court costs for any person convicted of a criminal offense if that

young person had been regular in attendance to a Bible class during that year. He never had to pay anyone's fine.

Attending Bible class is not a cure-all, but young people need all the help we can give them.
