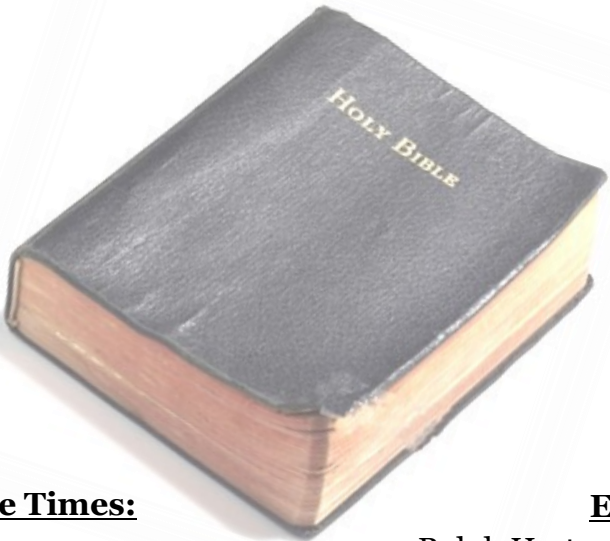

FRUITS OF MEDITATION

Psalms 119:97-105

Meditation is almost a lost art, but the great men of the Bible were men of mediation: Enoch, Abraham, Moses, Samuel, & David.

What is there to meditate on? God's Word, and our own "ways." "O how love it they law!" sings the Psalmist. Why? Because it furnishes him with happy thought all day.

It is good to form a habit of turning our thoughts to the things of God. It will enrich our life, and fill it with joy and faith.

Practical wisdom becomes ours, so that we can order our ways aright. In this passage the psalmist says, there are three practical fruits: (1) outwitting your enemies, (2) becoming wiser than your teachers, (3) understanding more than men of old.

But, meditation on God's Word and our "ways" does more. It holds us back from sin (verse 101). We begin to love good and despise evil. In fact, we come to relish God's truth as one desires honey. Jesus said, "My meat is to do the will of him that sent me" (John 4:34).

At best, religion that rests on fear, conscience, sense of duty, and hope of reward is feeble, but religion that delights in God is strong in all things.
