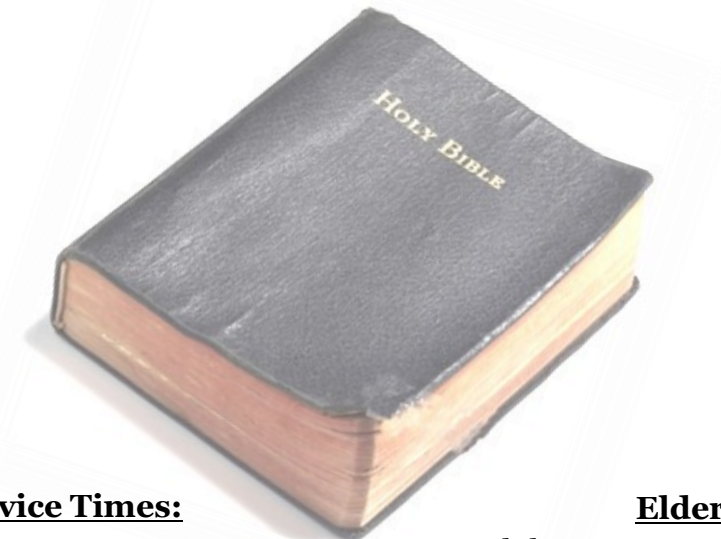

WE CAN BE BOLD IN PRAYER

"In whom we have boldness and access with confidence by the faith of him" (Ephesians 3:12).

There is a wonderful promise in Hebrews 4:15-16 which states, "For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. 16 Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need" (Hebrews 4:15-16).

We are not to come presumptuously, or arrogantly to God in prayer, but we can come boldly! This is not by our own merits, but because Christ, Himself has opened the way for us to approach God.

"Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus, 20 By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh; 21 And having an high priest over the house of God; 22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure wa-

ter" (Hebrews 10:19-22).

Jesus being free from sin, and having shed His blood, opened up the veil through his flesh, if we are faithful, and come to Him in faith we have access to God's throne of grace, and can come boldly, and make our petitions known.

Of course we understand that it depends on His will. "And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: 15 And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him" (John 5:14-15).

Whether a request is granted or denied it will be in accordance to the will of God. In His wisdom he grants, or denies our petitions for He knows what is best for us, but we can always find grace to help in times of need.

He is our great high priest, our mediator between us, and God the Father therefor we can come boldly through Jesus. We can have that confidence. Let us not neglect prayer.
