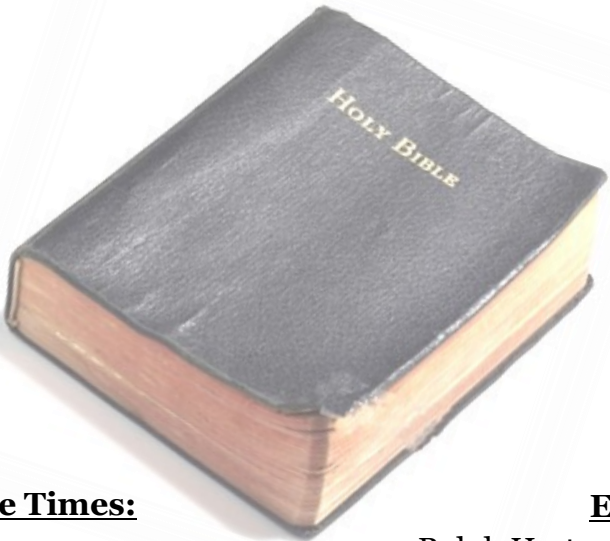

Withstanding Life's Tests

Life, at best, is not always easy. Easy street is sometimes pretty hard to find. It takes cold, winter weather to prove whether or not a tree is an evergreen. Isn't it true that with every difficulty there is an opportunity, and with every opportunity there is a difficulty? Can we find such a one as this in withstanding life's tests? I think of Joseph.

Joseph withstood the test of being petted. This is a test and not always easy to deal with. Many would have been spoiled but not Joseph. His being pampered did not affect the character of this young man. Joseph has a test of being envied. He was envied by his brothers. Many would have become vain through it. This was not the case with Joseph. Then there is a third test, and that was being mistreated. Joseph did not let this get to him, and irritate him. He worshipped a God that was greater than any of his problems. He still maintained a sterling character. Life can be cruel at times, and doors closed in our face. Then there comes the test of purity when he was tempted by Potiphar's wife. You can read the story in Genesis 39:1-10. He refused her advances, and continued to

maintain purity. He withstood the test unstained. We must come to think of each temptation, not as an opportunity to sin, but as an opportunity to refuse to sin. Joseph was determined to overcome, and he did. What a model to pattern a life after.

Then came the test of a false accusation, and a shattered reputation. The devil will not be out done, if he can help it. Joseph was falsely accused, and as a result was put in prison. But even then he still remained the same model he had always been. Even in prison he became so trustworthy that he was made a trustee in the prison. He was placed over the other prisoners which gave him opportunity to rise to the top again. He gave the meaning of the dreams of the butler and baker and that the butler would be released and the baker put to death. The butler was to remember him but forgot which another test was for Joseph? Through all of this and because of Joseph's faithfulness God blessed him. If we endure the test that life throws at us and remain true to God we will be blessed.
