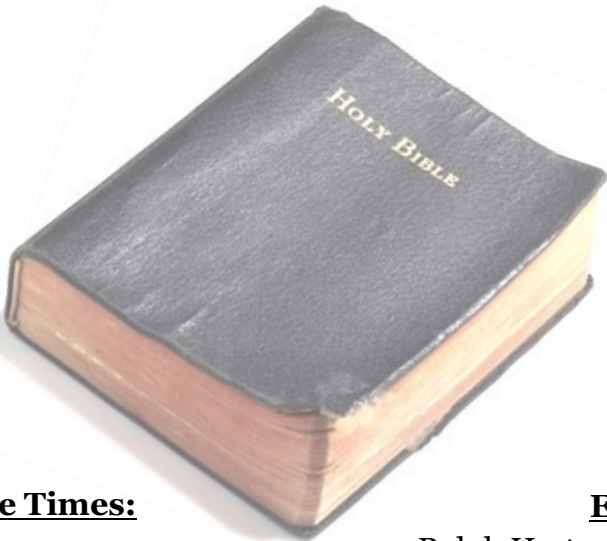

### **One of Paul's Travels**

Now, when they had gone throughout Phrygia, and the region of Galatia, and were forbidden of the Holy Ghost to preach the word in Asia (Acts 16:6).

Paul was going west on one of the Roman highways toward the province of Asia. His aim was to preach the gospel, probably in one of the large cities on the coast of the Aegean Sea, but something happened. The Holy Spirit made Paul change his mind, and he took off from the highway, and went up north through the Phrygian, and Galatian region.

Detained in Galatia by illness, he used some of his time there to preach the gospel, and to found a church. He also won some new wonderful friends. Most of us prefer to travel on main highways since they are so convenient. We pass by many people and places, but they are of no immediate concerns of ours until something happens.

We then discover that God has
