ENCOURAGEMENT FOR THE FEARFUL

Isaiah 43:1 *"But now thus saith the LORD that created thee, O Jacob, and he that formed thee, O Israel, Fear not: for I have redeemed thee, I have called thee by thy name; thou art mine."*

Marshal Saxe, who loved to look upon the ranks of opposing armies, fled and screamed in terror at the sight of a cat.

There are so many things that people fear. Maybe you have a fear of this coronavirus that is sweeping the country and seems to be growing daily and many have died and the estimate is that many more will die before this is over.

Strange fears of impending disaster, or coming sorrow, of threatening calamity; fears sometimes remain unclear, and weigh like a load of lead upon our lives.

Yes, even today we are somewhat in a state of fear. But, we must trust in the Lord and in His word for comfort; and to motivate us to continue on with our lives.

From Isaiah 43:1 we can read the

words of our Lord when he says, "Fear not." I know the passage was written in a different time period, but Malachi 3:6 says, "For I am the LORD, I change not..."

We must trust and depend on God to see us through this trying time.

There are two things that can bring on fear and that is depression and discouragement.

These two enemies have worked havoc and maybe you are in that state now; because we are not to do the things that we are used to doing on a daily basis.

As a result of the virus we are instructed to stay a good distance from other people, to stay at home as much as possible, be sure to wash your hands, all of which can cause and element of fear.

We are not allowed to visit a member in the hospital or a family member in the nursing home which causes discouragement and with that an element of fear as to whether they are being care for as they should be. So I leave you with these words.

Hebrews 13:5-6, *"Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. 6. So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me."*
