OUR INHERITANCE

Job 31:2 “For what portion of God is there from above? And what inheritance of the Almighty from on high?”

Relatively few people receive much of an inheritance in this life, but everyone has an inheritance from above.

Job 31:3 “Is not destruction to the wicked? And a strange punishment to the workers of iniquity?”

The Christian, however, will “receive the promise of eternal inheritance” (Hebrews 9:15), and this is far better than a worldly estate.

Our inheritance is shared with the Son of God Himself—“joint heirs with Christ” (Romans 8:17), and inheritance utterly secure. Peter speaks of the great inheritance that awaits the Christian.

1 Peter 1:4-5 “To an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you, 5 Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.”

In answer to Job's plaintive question of long ago, we do, indeed, have a glorious inheritance from on high: “To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne” is the promise of the great Heir Himself (Revelation 3:21).

From what we read in the New Testament Jesus died so that we might inherit eternal life in heaven. The inheritance is firm, however, and the victory is sure for the obedient child of God. RH
