THE GROUND OF FAITH

I think we could say it like Peter did: *“The word of God which liveth and abideth forever”* (1 Peter 1:23). Isaiah said this: *“He that believeth as the Scriptures hath said”* (Isaiah 7:38).

Every word of God is purified (Proverbs 30:5). There is no dross, nothing to be put away. To be received just as it is given.

We are to desire the sincere milk of the word. Many seek to boil it down before receiving it. They attempt to refine what God has already purified. The Word is not only pure, but “sure.”

We have a sure word of prophecy. The Word of the Lord shall stand forever (Isaiah 40:8). Because it is already “settled in heaven” (Psalm 119:89).

Then the ground of our faith is as faithful and true as the Object of our faith which is Christ. What we must do is exercise our faith by reading and study.
