We meet at 4:00 p.m. each Sunday in the sanctuary of Vine Street Christian Church (4101 Harding Pike, Nashville, TN 37205).

Our services are liturgical, and we follow the Revised Common Lectionary and church calendar. Home to a large number of M.Div. students and theology professors,

we rotate male and female preachers, communion officiants, and worship leaders each week. Our worship is a blend of acapella and instrumental (depending on who is leading), and we get to experience both male and female members offering prayers and reading Scripture.

We have no official elders or deacons at this point and instead are practicing liturgy without hierarchy.

Our goal is that everyone may serve according to his or her giftedness and that the ‘priesthood of ALL believers’ would be both a theology and a lived practice.

Each week, 100% of our contribution goes to a different faith-based charity, as we have no paid staff and no overhead costs.”
