DARKNESS

Matthew 4:16 *“The people which sat in darkness saw great light; and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death light is sprung up”.*

Darkness always stands as a position of one who is separated from God. It is a person’s condition without Christ.

Darkness implies a state of ignorance. Christ is the light of the world but to be ignorant of Christ is to be in darkness about the truth of the gospel.

If we are ignorant of Christ the only way to come to the light is through the means that Christ reveals to us.

Many people in darkness are very superstitious. Of course where there is no light there is

sure to be false views and false teachers leading people down the wrong road to eternal condemnation.

The person’s darkened mind cannot think the thoughts of God, and so he follows his own fanciful ideas.

Also, where there is darkness there is danger. Those in darkness cannot see and that makes their condition all the more perilous.

For they have not come to the light, so they can see the way of life. They continue to stumble in darkness which leads to death.

We also understand that to be in darkness means we are helpless. The verse says *“They sat in darkness.”* Meaning they did not know where to go or what to do.

Without light one is helpless to find his way. But, when the light comes, his eyes are able to see and find the way that leads to life eternal.

Jesus is the light of the world, so we don’t have to be in darkness if we are willing to follow the light that he set before us.
