Counterfeit Churches

With photocopiers, and computers, counterfeit money these days may look very close to the real thing, but if it is not made by the U.S. Treasury or Mint, then it is no good.

It has to have the authority of the government behind it, to be legal tender.

In nominal Christianity there are many counterfeit churches. Not everything that passes for a church ought to be considered acceptable, for not all have the backing of the authority of heaven.

Sadly, some folks seem to care very little whether the church they join is legitimate or not.

Many times churches may be close to the real thing; but close is not good enough. In Jesus' days on earth there were sects (denominations) of the Jewish

There is a story in the book of Joshua of some Gibeonites who tried to fool Israel into thinking they were distant travelers rather than locals, in order to be spared.

They dressed themselves up to look the part and it worked. But, if you notice in Joshua 9:14, the Bible says the men of Israel did not ask counsel of the Lord. This was their big mistake.

They went on appearances and failed to check things out with God.

Don't be fooled by the appearances of churches. Don't be a part of a counterfeit church. Search God's word and see if things are so.
