FORGIVE AND FORGET

When Stephen was being stoned to death he had no words of retaliation but only words of forgiveness.

Acts 7:60 "And he kneeled down, and cried with a loud voice, Lord, lay not this sin to their charge. And when he had said this, he fell asleep".

Is he not a good example of forgiveness when enemies was stoning him to death and he is asking the Lord to forgive them?

What we have done even when it is some lesser thing done to us? Here is Stephen as God not to remember the cruel action of those who were killing him.

It is hard to imagine such forgiveness in a human heart. Most of us react just the opposite.

We tend to hold grudges and become angry over minor events.

Our lives suffer from these feelings as do the lives of those we don't forgive.

In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus told us to love our enemies, do well to those who hate us, bless those who curse us, pray for those who abuse us.

If all of us who read these words would begin to practice them the effect would be overwhelming.

We must set aside our hatreds anger, and jealousies and take heed to the instruction that our Lord has given us if we expect to be like him.

His words and our response to them will accomplish what is intended.
