Dear Brethren,

Jerris and Juanita Bullard continue to travel about the brotherhood doing fundraising which is an essential part of mission work. They are doing well and express their appreciation to all of the brethren who constantly encourage them and keep them in prayer without which they could not do this work.

The Lord's work in India continues to experience large numbers of souls being taught the Word, coming to faith, repentance and baptism in His name. More than 2,000 people are baptized every day. To God be the glory and thanksgiving for his grace and mercy to us all. It is a joy to be involved in this great, historic mission work for the Lord. We are so thankful for you and many others like yourself who are coworkers with us in the Lord's vineyard. God has so arranged the work so that we can all be missionaries through our prayers and gifts which fund the many works, and letters of encouragement. God uses us all in whatever capacity He gives us to do His will. We are thankful for each and every one who works with us. Some can go to India while others are supportive in so many ways. We thank you for your partnership.

This has been an exceptionally fine year for the India Mission work. We have constructed four different church buildings and have three others in various stages of nearing completion. We have a new dormitory for our Preacher training School in Pamidipado-within one month of being completed. Additionally, in drought stricken areas we have completed drilling three water wells which serve not only the local preacher, but numerous others who come to our wells to take of the water free of charge. This often leads folks to study the Gospel with the local brethren.

It is time for us to print another 10,000 Telegu song books. You may recall that this book was produced under the leadership of brother K. Vandanam (who passed away in 2017), over a period of five years with the assistance and input of

hundreds of Indian brethren. We have printed and distributed 50,000 of these songbooks which were made possible by your gifts. It costs about \$1.25 per hardback songbook which is a very high quality book designed to last for years of service. The songbooks are a great blessing where generally the brethren get by on a few Xerox pages of hymns plus songs they may have memorized over the years. Imagine what it would be like to try to worship without a songbook. The same may be said for the Bible. There is a shortage of Bibles in the local languages which we can purchase in India printed by the Indian Bible Society. In addition to providing funds for us to print songbooks, please think about supplying a few Bibles as well, which can be purchased locally in the various State capital cities of India for about \$4.00 each.

Our greatest need is to raise funds for daily opportunities for evangelism. Please pray for the lost to be taught, and then give fifteen dollars to send a native preacher to them for one day. We have a great workforce of about 50,000 native preachers who are ready to go ... if only they have the funds to pay bus fares, eat a small meal, and stay overnight in most cases in a dormitory type hotel which costs \$5.00 per night. Thank you for remembering our work for the glory of God.
