THINGS ABOUT CHRIST

ACTS 10:38-44

When Peter went to the house of Cornelius he spoke several things in regards to Jesus. I want to list

them.

Jesus the Anointed One. "God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit" (v.38)

Jesus, the Compassionate One. "Who went about doing good."

Jesus the Mighty One. "Healing all that were oppressed of the devil."

Jesus, the Suffering One. "Whom they slew and hanged on a tree" (v.39).

Jesus, the Risen One. "Him God raised up the third day."

Jesus, the Exalted One. "Ordained of God to be the Judge of quick and dead" (v.42).

Jesus, the Universal Saving One.

Whosoever believeth in Him shall receive remission of sins" (v. 43)

Through His name the door of mercy and grace opened up a way for us to have redemption and eternal life.

But let me remind you when this door of mercy and grace is shut no man will be able to enter in (Luke 13:24-25)

The effect of Peter's sermon concerning Jesus was accepted by Cornelius, but will the sermon by Peter on Pentecost be accepted by you?
