SALVATION THROUGH THE WORD

2 KINGS 22:11

This experience of Judah's good King Josiah illustrates the convicting power of the Scriptures. It points up the essential importance of the revealed word of God in the process of repentance, forgiveness, and salvation.

It is the word of God which brings conviction of one's need of salvation, and this is the indispensable first step leading to salvation. "For by the law is the

knowledge of sin" (Romans 3:20).

It is also through the Scriptures that one comes to an understanding of salvation: "The Holy Scriptures... are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus" (2 Tim. 3:15).

Furthermore, it is the work which generates saving faith: "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God" (Romans 10:17).

Finally, the transforming of lost souls into a right relationship with God is through an obedience to the gospel by being baptized into Christ, (Gal. 3:27) and then rising to walk in newness of life (Romans 6:3-6).

James says, "Of His own will begat He us with the word of truth" (James 1:18). Also Peter said, "Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth forever" (1 Peter 1:23).

The result of King Josiah's reading the word was that he "made a covenant before the Lord, to walk after the Lord, and to keep His commandments" (2 Kings 23:3).

When we obey we also make a covenant with the Lord to walk in His ways for the rest of our lives here on earth.
