BEHIND THY BACK

Isaiah 38:17 *“Behold, for peace I had great bitterness: but thou hast in love to my soul delivered it from the pit of corruption: for thou hast cast all my sins behind thy back.”*

This is part of good King Hezekiah’s outburst of praise to God on his recovery from a most serious illness.

He remembered, and placed on record, that, though in common with others, he had cast God behind his back, yet, on confessing his sin, and seeking mercy.

God had cast his sin behind His back. And there are thousands today who can, and do, give the same glad and joyous testimony. This is not according to our deserts.

If we received our due, He would treat us as we have treated Him. And does He act this way because He thinks lightly of sin?

For answer to the question go to Calvary. Jesus, our Lord, suffered in our stead. It is because God cast His beloved Son on the cross, that He can now cast the repentant obedient sinner’s sin behind His back.

“My sin is ever before me,” (Psalm 51:3), moaned king David having a broken and contrite heart of sorrow.

Yes that is it; when the sinner sets his sins before his own face and obeys, then it is that the merciful Lord sets them behind His back. Are we not glad that God does that and never remembers them in the future?
