PAUL OBTAINED MERCY

1 Timothy 1:16

He like we needed mercy. According to his own confession he was "chief of sinners" (v. 15).

He was the ringleader among the enemies of Christ. He was like us because, we were sinners needing the mercy of God.

He obtained mercy. He did not obtain it by any work of merit of his own and neither do we. He obtained it because of God's grace.

He obtained it because he readily accepted the gift of salvation through obedience to the gospel the same as each of us.

He obtained mercy through Jesus Christ (v.15). There is none

other name under heaven through which God's forgiveness is obtained all as the result of the blood of Christ.

He obtained mercy that he might be a pattern to them which would hereafter believe on him.

He not only became an exhibition of the grace of God, but an example to encourage all those who desired to trust Jesus and obey with a view of obtaining that mercy which means "life everlasting."

Seeing, then, that the conversion of Saul is to be taken as a sample of the saving mercy of God; what great encouragement there is for sinners of every age to believe on the Lord Jesus Christ.

If you are seeking life, eternal life here is God's mercy extended to you through obedience to the gospel.
