Only the Truth Matters

Matthew 16:1-12

How sad it is when our knowledge of material things is so much more interesting that the understanding of spiritual matters.

The Lord notes that the Pharisees and Sadducees were able to interpret the weather much better than they could understand and interpret the sign of the prophet Jonas.

A renowned American writer of a past generation was traveling with his small daughter in Europe. During their travels, they met many individuals of great prestige.

The small daughter was so impressed that she said to her father one night, “Daddy, I think that you know everyone but God.” How unfortunate when this is the case!

Jesus warns the people of “the doctrine of the Pharisees and Sadducees.” This doctrine, which rejected Christ, could easily spread to the most people.

Maybe it reminds us of what Paul said in 1 Corinthians 5:6, “Know ye not that a little leaven leaveneth the whole lump.” Just as surely as we wish to avoid some terrible event, we should avoid accepting even the smallest amount of false teaching.
