#### **LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR**

Proverbs 24:28-29 "Be not a witness against thy neighbour without cause; and deceive not with thy lips. 29 Say not, I will do so to him as he hath done to me: I will render to the man according to his work." There is a great example in the Bible concerning someone who did not have

regard for his neighbor. King Ahab wanted the vineyard of his neighbor, Naboth. You remember that Naboth refused to sale or trade so Ahab's wife Jezebel devised a plan against Naboth to take it by force or you might say steal it.

So she proclaimed a fast and sit two sons of Belial before Naboth to bear false witness against him. They said you have blaspheme God and the king.
