CHRIST and PRAYER

The life of Jesus proclaims “follow me.” Any person who follows Jesus will be led by the still waters of prayer. Jesus lived a life of prayer. No one else in the New Testament prayed more than Jesus.

Jesus prayed at his baptism. After feeding the five thousand he went up into the mountains apart to pray. Before choosing the twelve apostles, Jesus continued all night in prayer to God.

Before the agony of the cross, the Son of God prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane with such earnestness that sweat rolled from his face as great drops of blood.

The Son of God recognized the necessity of spending many hours in prayer to God. How can we as adopted children of God be above the need of prayer?

Come and let's make our supplications know to God. Let's go before the throne of God with an expression of thanksgiving, with the

confession of sins, with a request for forgiveness, and with a plea on behalf of others.

We have the opportunity to talk to God, with full assurance of having God's will done in our life because of prayer. God beckons his man to approach him in prayer.

In Isaiah 65:24 God makes a promise to the children of Israel. “And it shall come to pass, that before they call, I will answer; and while they are yet speaking, I will hear.” Jesus said, “Ask, and it shall be given you; seek and ye shall find: knock and it shall be opened unto you.”

Man need not worry about receiving, or finding, or opening. All man has to do is to ask, seek, and knock. When we continue to ask, seek and knock according to the will of God, we will have the blessed assurance that God will grant the response.

Every child of God can come boldly before the throne of grace, to obtain mercy, and to find grace to help in time of need.

There is no reason to be heavy laden with distressing anxieties. Peace of mind can be obtained by asking, seeking, knocking, and letting God answer.
