THE ROCK HIGHER THAN I

David said, "From the end of the earth I will cry to You. When my heart is overwhelmed: Lead me to the rock that is higher than I." {Psalm 61:2}

David was often in situations that overwhelmed him. He was hotly pursued by

Saul seeking his life. He faced rebellion I his son Absalom and fled for his life. David also suffered greatly from the guilt of his sin with Bathsheba. One need only to read the Psalms to see the heart of this king who was a "man after God's own heart."

Yes, David knew there was One to whom he could go for solace in time so life's storms. He spoke of a "rock that is higher than I." Who is the Rock of which he speaks? For David (and us) this Rock is the Lord. In Psalms 62:7 David says, "In God is my salvation and my glory; the rock of my strength, And my refuge, is in God.

Paul identified the Rock that traveled with the Israelites as Christ. (1 Corinthians 10:4) Jesus is the Rock higher than I. In times when you are overwhelmed, go to Him!
