GOD'S MERCY

Psalms 103:10-11

"He hath not dealt with us after our sins; nor rewarded us according to our iniquities. 11 For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is his mercy toward them that fear him."

As we very well know no one deserves the mercy of God, for as Isaiah says

"we have turned everyone to his own way" (Isaiah 53:6).

And we know that from scripture for Paul said *"all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23).*

We know also that the wages of sin is death (Romans 6:23). Therefore we all deserved death and separation from God. But in spite of that, "it is of the Lord's mercies that we are not consumed, because
