SOMETHING TO THINK ABOUT!

In the book of Philippians Paul praises the congregation there for their help in providing the things that he stood in need of. Notice some verses.

Philippians 4:10, *“But I rejoiced in the Lord greatly, that now at the last your care of me hath flourished again; wherein ye were also careful, but ye lacked opportunity.”*

Philippians 4:14-16, *“Notwithstanding ye have well done, that ye did communicate with my affliction. 15 Now ye Philippians know also, that in the beginning of the gospel, when I departed from Macedonia, no church communicated with me as concerning giving and receiving, but ye only. 16 For even in Thessalonica ye sent once and again unto my necessity”.*

Paul wrote these words out of his deep gratitude for their financial support and encouragement.

He realized he could never repay them, he sent in this letter that they had the promise of God to meet and needs they might have.

Philippians 4:19, *“But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus”.*

Likewise these words give us the source from which all our needs are fully met. You notice in the verse above Paul begins with “My God.”

That is God is the source of every blessing and need you and I have in life and he gives it fully and abundantly.

James 1:17, *“Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.”*

You cannot out give God. We have needs for our souls, for our families and for our friends, for the present and for the future, for time and eternity.

Let us bring our pressing needs to God. He can fulfill them out if His riches in Christ as no one else can. If we don't get what we need, then maybe it was a want instead of a need.

In God's love we can say as the psalmist, *“The Lord is my shepherd: I shall not want.”*
