## WHAT ABOUT OUR SPEECH

The Christian's speech is of extreme importance. Paul said: *"Let your speech be always with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how you ought to answer every man"* (Colossians 4:6)

Also Jesus had this to say: *"Every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of Judgment"* (Matthew 12:36)

When we think of every word it should be that our words are gracious and that they leave a good taste to others, never should they be hurtful, or crude or ugly.

I guess we could think in the terms of what James says about the tongue and how it can destroy.

James says: *"Even so the tongue is a little member, and boasteth great things. Behold, how great a matter a little fire kindleth"* (James 3:5).

James goes on the talk about how the tongue is a fire a world of iniquity and James says it can defile the whole body and James says no man can tame it.

So we can see why using the tongue in a correct way controlling it is very important.

Paul says again: *"But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth"* (Colossians 3:8).

So our words should be edifying and helpful to others.
