BE PATIENT

“Rest in the Lord, and wait patiently for him” (Psalm 37:7)

IMPATIENCE is often called the vice of the virtuous. A child once prayed, “Lord, make all the bad people good, and the good people nice.”

Today I will not upset others by being cross. I will not selfishly release my feelings of frustration without first thinking about others.

“The secret of patience is doing something constructive in the

meantime.” Patience is waiting on God and trusting him to work things out in his time. It is not worrying while waiting for God’s answer.

It is shown by a child who does not grab back a toy. It is shown by a mother who does not demand perfect quiet from the children just because she is tired.

It is shown by a father who realizes he will feel better after dinner, and determines to show tolerance until dinner.

“**ANGER**” is just one letter short of “danger.” With God’s help I can deal with my emotions. Perhaps the efforts will be feeble at first, but I shall begin. It is not hypocritical to act composed when you feel upset.

“The little plans I tried to carry through have failed, I will not sorrow. I’ll pause a little while, and try, again, tomorrow.”
