WHAT DO WE LONG FOR?

1 Thessalonians 1:10 “And to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, even Jesus, which delivered us from the wrath to come.”

The church at Thessalonica had turned from idols to serve the living God; not only that, but to wait for His Son from Heaven.

In the Old Testament on the Day of Atonement the High Priest went into the Most Holy Place to offer the blood of animals for atonement.

Now Christ, our Great High Priest went

into Heaven to offer his blood on our behalf. As a result of this, the Lord has told us that he will come for his church. We as Christians long for that time, not knowing when that time may be.

Paul said in Philippians 3:20, that “our citizenship is in Heaven, from whence we look for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ.”

God has made preparation for us to be ready when the Lord does come back. He has promised us that he will come again and when he does we will be able to be with him (John 14:1-3).

We long for the completion of our salvation. The Hebrew writer said this: Hebrews 9:28 “So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation.”

Our salvation now, great as it is, is but the foretaste of what is yet to come. We have been saved from the penalty and power of sin, but not from its presence. Suffering and sorrow are still associated with our present condition.

But, when the Lord comes to claim his own all the suffering and sorrow and sin will be no more. We will be able to live in peace and harmony with the redeemed and with our Lord.

Is that not a reason to long for the Lord's return? When he comes he will change our mortal body to be fashioned like unto His glorious body (Philippians 3:20-21).
