## CASTING DOWN IMAGINATIONS

One of the things the sword of the Spirit does is destroy those things in our character, which are contrary to the knowledge of God, that every thought may be brought into full obedience to Christ.

We read Paul's words, 2 Corinthians 10:3-5, "*For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: 4. For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;*

*5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;*"

Thus we see that the purpose of the sword of the Spirit; according to this scripture, is to nullify all teachings and influences, even those within our own hearts and minds that would subvert the knowledge of God.
