## EARNESTLY CONTEND FOR THE FAITH

### JUDE 3

Jude is a short letter, but has some important messages for us today. Jude is addressed to Christians. Here in verse 3, Jude is not merely suggesting that we contend for the faith; it is a command to do so.

It may be easy to ignore this command, but it is important that we always contend for the faith.

His exhortation to "earnestly contend" does not mean to "be argumentative," but rather, to "agonize with intense determination." It is one word in the Greek, "epagonizomia" (literally, "agonize over").

Defending and contending for the faith is serious, urgent business, for the adversaries are many.

There are many even today that are destroying the faith that brings about salvation by teaching things that are false and not according to the word of God.

As this verse says the faith has been "once delivered" to the

saints. It is something that will never be repeated with additions or subtraction.

This is more centered on the good news that the gospel presents, that brings about salvation of the soul.

The Lord has given us His word and we have the responsibility to keep, and not to change anything about it.

This is not written to preachers, but to every member of the Lord's church. So stay true to the sound doctrine once delivered.
