IMPORTANCE OF WISDOM

James 1:13-14

If one would demonstrate that he is really wise, he can do so, the writer states, only by manifesting the right kind of life and speaking only that which is good. True wisdom does not speak

boastfully, nor use the tongue improperly. If jealousy and a factious spirit obtain, one's boasting all in vain.

Moreover, all such is positively false. Those who thus do, simply lie. To be thus influenced is not to possess the true wisdom; it is not to be governed and motivated by the wisdom which is from above, but that which springs from below; that which is earthly, of the devil and not of God; sensual; fleshly; and devilish, diabolical in nature.

Where envying and strife prevail, all is confusion and tumult. There is no mutual confidence; there is no union of plan and effort; there is no cooperation in promoting a common object; but every evil work obtains. When we take into account that by far the most common cause of strife is the abuse of the tongue, we are enabled to see the importance of heeding the admonitions here given.

"But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gently, easy to be entreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without variance, without hypocrisy. And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace for them that make peace." (James 3:17-18)
