## TEMPTATION

Mark 1:12-13 *“And immediately the Spirit driveth him into the wilderness. 13 And he was there in the wilderness forty days, tempted of Satan; and was with the wild beasts; and the angels ministered unto him”.*

When we think about the temptation of Jesus we realize that temptation is probably the most familiar thing that the Christian faces in life.

We think of the Christian life as a life of joy and peace, yet many will say that they do not see it that way. If we speak of it as a life of temptation then every soul will readily and immediately admit that such is the case.

Think about this as we contemplate the

temptation of Jesus, and realize that Jesus was tempted in all points as we are. Notice: Hebrews 4:15 *“For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin”.*

There is nothing that we experience that Jesus has not experienced himself. He suffered being tempted and to be tempted really meant suffering to Him as it does to us. Since he has suffered being tempted He is able to help us. Hebrews 2:18, *“For in that he himself hath suffered being tempted, he is able to succour them that are tempted”.*

Think about this and note the distinction between sin and temptation. Is not a sin to be tempted.

Sin has it beginning when we begin to play with temptation like a cat plays with a mouse. James says in James 1:13-16 *“Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man: 14 But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed. 15 Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death. 16 Do not err, my beloved brethren.”*

Jesus conquered, and He did so by the word. He said, “it is written.”

Today we have the same word and we can use it to our advantage when faced with temptation. We can overcome by remembering what the word of God says. Think about it.

RH
