THE LIFE I HAVE NOW

GALATIANS 2:16-21

What Paul speaks of in this section of scripture is truly not the life he used to have and neither is it the life of a Christian now.

Paul at one time live under the Law of Moses but now he explains that he along with Christians have a life justified without the deeds of the Law of Moses. He says: "By the works of the law shall no flesh be justified" (v. 16). The law could not forgive sin, but the law taught what sin was (Gal. 3:19). To be justified is to be free from sin and the guilt of sin.

Next Paul teaches us that life comes through faith in Christ (v.16). "We have believed in Jesus Christ that we might be justified by faith in Christ." It is by faith that the righteousness of God is imputed to the Christian. The Law was a school master to bring us to Christ so

that we might be justified by faith (Gal. 3:24). Paul said in Romans 5:1, "Therefor being justified by faith, we have peace with God." Now that one is justified he or she has a life lived unto God. Paul said: "I am dead to the law that I might live unto God" (v.19).

Paul also tells us that this old life was crucified with Christ. "I am crucified with Christ" (v. 20). The old man, with all his fleshly passions and lusts is crucified with Christ, that the body of sin might be destroyed (Romans 6:6). Paul said In Gal. 6:14 "God forbid that I should glory, save in the Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world."

Now as a Christian that has been justified by obedient faith Christ lives in us, (v.20). One has now become a new person, who has a new will, a new purpose, a new way of living life. On in which Jesus is the focus. Ephesians 3:16-17

"...to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man; 17 That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love,"

Then Paul closes out this section with the focus of a life of continual faith in the Son of God, "The life I now live in the flesh, I live by the faith in the Son of God" (v.20). This life we have now begins with faith in Christ and with a continuous act of faith in Christ. We live by faith and not by sight.

He that will endure to the end in this steadfast attitude of unailing faith will be saved eternally. (Hebrews 11:6).
