Our Enemy

1 Peter 5: 8-14

Is there a real Devil? Of course there is.! "A gang of thieves is never as dangerous as when they have it widely rumored that they have left the neighborhood."

The Devil is spoken as our adversary. And here we are told he is the Devil. Think about his guises.

He has a fairly extensive wardrobe. He is a quick-change artist. He has three common and familiar guises. He assails us more frequently in either of these

three guises than any other.

Let's look at them as they come in biblical order.

Serpent (Genesis 3:14; Revelation 12:9).

In one sense a serpent is more dangerous than a Roaring Lion. This name suggest that he beguiles our senses, perverts our judgment, and enchants our imagination.

Angel of Light (2 Corinthians 11:14).

Deceiving with false views of spiritual things. As such he poses as an evangelist, and teacher, that undermines the faith he is professing to teach, by his deceptive ways.

"If the evil that charges us were as frightful in its characteristic as it is in its essence, we could run little danger from its assaults; but often it besets us in fair forms and dazzlingly colored, and here lies its peril." It deceives and then takes one captive.

Roaring Lion (1 Peter 5:8).

There is the terror in its threatening. It roars and bring fear. It is strong and able to bring one down. It seeks to destroy us by violent oppositions.

Our duty is to keep cool, keep awake and resist. We are to give no place to the devil. We must stand against the fiery darts of the evil on.

Curb our passions and exercise self-control. Keep the faith and never give in to the Devil ways.
